Disbarment

On October 22, 2015, a Hearing Committee of the Benchers of the Law Society of Alberta ordered **Rakesh Dewett** disbarred, effective immediately. Mr. Dewett lived and practiced in Calgary, Alberta until his membership was suspended by the Benchers pursuant to section 63 of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, on November 21, 2013.

The Hearing Committee found that Mr. Dewett's conduct was deserving of sanction on citations involving purchasing property at an inflated price for an improper purpose, providing false letters of employment to a lender, failing to serve clients, failing to be candid with and respond to communications from the Law Society, failing to comply with undertakings to the Law Society, swearing false statutory declarations, and ungovernability.

The Hearing Committee ordered that Mr. Dewett pay two-thirds of the actual costs of the hearing, estimated to be \$44,593.48.
