Disbarment

On April 8, 2011, a Hearing Committee disbarred **Mr. John A. Sutherland**, who resides in Calgary, Alberta, and who practised in Calgary until August 7, 2009, when he was suspended by the Benchers under section 63 of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, in relation to other conduct matters.

The Hearing Committee found that **Mr. Sutherland's** conduct was deserving of sanction on five citations in that he had improperly exercised a solicitor's lien pertaining to outstanding accounts of another client over the proceeds of sale of the complaining client, that he had acted in a conflict of interest, that he had failed to conscientiously serve his client by failing to protect, account for and release the proceeds of sale, that he wrongfully converted a portion of his client's proceeds of sale, and that he failed to respond to the Law Society in a complete and appropriate manner. **Mr. Sutherland** had notice but did not appear at the hearing.

The Hearing Committee ordered that **Mr. Sutherland** be disbarred immediately and pay the actual costs of the hearing fixed at \$5,500.00.
