NOTICE OF DISBARMENT

On December 1, 2009, a Hearing Committee found **Bradley W. Enge**, who resided in Yellowknife and practised in Edmonton until his suspension on March 31, 2007, guilty of the following citations: that he failed to serve and account to his client, that he charged his client a fee that exceeded a fair and reasonable amount, that he breached a trust condition, and that he failed to cooperate with the Law Society during the course of its investigation.

The Hearing Committee ordered, pursuant to Section 72 (1)(a) of the *Legal Profession Act*, that the member be disbarred. The member is required to pay the actual costs of the hearing.
