Notice of Suspension

On June 9, 2010, a Hearing Committee accepted the admission of guilt of the member and found that the conduct of **Susan Hendricks**, who resides in Victoria, British Columbia, and formerly practised in Calgary, Alberta, was deserving of sanction in that she failed to comply with the direction of a Hearing Committee and failed to respond to the Law Society in a timely manner.

The Hearing Committee directed, pursuant to section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, that the membership of **Ms. Hendricks** be suspended for one month. The Hearing Committee further ordered that **Ms. Hendricks** is required to pay the actual costs of the hearing, estimated to be \$2,824.50.

Ms. Hendricks has been suspended since April 26, 2007 and is required to participate in a reinstatement review prior to changing her practice status.
