Suspension

On June 28, 2007, a Hearing Committee found that the conduct of **Mr. Jeffrey Plantje**, who resides in Winnipeg, Manitoba, was deserving of sanction in that he sexually harassed two female co-workers, while he was practicing in Alberta.

The Hearing Committee directed, pursuant to section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, that the membership of the member be suspended for 30 days, having already been on the inactive list for a year, and not to be reinstated to active practice without a mandatory referral to the Practice Review Committee.
