SUSPENSION

SPECIFICS:

On March 11, 2005, a Hearing Committee found **Mr. Roy Peter Rasmusen** guilty on three citations. Mr. Rasmusen resides and practises in Calgary, Alberta.

The citations on which Mr. Rasmusen was found guilty are as follows: one citation involving failing to follow accounting rules, one citation involving breach of an undertaking to maintain his firm's books and records, and one citation involving failing to respond to the Law Society.

The Hearing Committee ordered, pursuant to Section 72 of the *Legal Profession Act,* R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, that the membership of the member be suspended for six months commencing at the close of business on March 18, 2005. As a condition of reinstatement, the member shall satisfy the Practice Review Committee that there are in place adequate safeguards to ensure compliance with the accounting rules of the Law Society of Alberta.

The Hearing Committee imposed a fine of \$2,500.00. Actual costs of the hearing, less adjournment costs, were also ordered.
