## **Suspension**

On October 12, 2006, a Hearing Committee found that the conduct of **Mr. Shaun Langin**, who resides in and practices in Kelowna, B.C. and formerly practised in the Town of Sylvan Lake, Alberta, was deserving of sanction. In numerous cases, he failed to fulfill his commitments to his clients and to other solicitors and failed to respond in a timely manner to numerous inquiries from the Law Society of Alberta.

The Hearing Committee directed, pursuant to section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, that the membership of the member be suspended for one month, commencing November 6, 2006. The Hearing Committee also ordered that the member pay a fine of \$5,000 and the costs of the hearing.
