Disbarment

On September 11, 2008, a Hearing Committee disbarred **Mr. Terry L. Britton**, who resides in Calgary, Alberta, and who practiced in Calgary until March 31, 2006, when he was suspended by a previous Hearing Committee in other disciplinary proceedings under the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8.

The Hearing Committee found that **Mr. Britton's** conduct was deserving of sanction on three citations in that he failed to comply with accounting rules, that he failed to cooperate fully with a Law Society investigation, and that he failed to respond to the Law Society. **Mr. Britton** had actual notice but did not appear at the hearing.

The Hearing Committee ordered that **Mr. Britton** be disbarred immediately and pay the actual costs of the hearing estimated to be in the amount of \$4,005.75.

As custodial arrangements for **Mr. Britton's** practice are already in place no custodian was appointed.
