Suspension

On June 16, 2010, a Hearing Committee found Shelley Noel Phillips, a suspended member of the Law Society who resides and formerly practised in Calgary, Alberta, guilty of conduct deserving of sanction on three citations involving failing to report criminal charges and engaging in conduct which impaired her capacity to provide competent service and brings discredit to the profession .

The Hearing Committee ordered, pursuant to section 72(1)(b) of the Legal Profession Act, R.S.A. 200, c. L-8 that the member be suspended for three months, effective immediately.

A custodian had previously been appointed of Ms. Phillips' practice.
