Suspension

On December 14, 2015, a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta found the conduct of **Kamal Mahmudi-Azer**, a member of the Law Society who lives and practices in Calgary, Alberta, to be deserving of sanction on four citations and pursuant to Section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act* R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8. The Hearing Committee ordered that Mr. Mahmudi-Azer will be suspended for four months commencing immediately.

The conduct deserving of sanction involved failing to reply promptly and completely to and cooperate with the Law Society, failing to provide reasonable notice of withdrawal and to take all reasonable steps to facilitate orderly transfer of a client matter on withdrawal, failing to provide an accounting for funds received and disbursed, and failing to comply with the accounting rules of the Law Society.

As Mr. Mahmudi-Azer's status was inactive, no custodian will be appointed.

The full written decision of the Hearing Committee will be posted to the Law Society of Alberta website when it is issued.
