## Suspension

Effective March 1, 2013, Ned Ephraim Frohlic, who resides and practiced in Edmonton, Alberta, was automatically suspended pursuant to section 83(7) of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8 because he was convicted of an indictable offence under section 380 (1) (A) of the *Criminal Code* and was sentenced to a term of imprisonment. The Law Society was only recently advised of this conviction and imprisonment for sixteen months.

Mr. Frohlic was previously suspended for non-payment of fees on March 31, 2011, and has not been an active member since that date.
