## Suspension

On June 16, 2014, a Hearing Committee found the conduct of **Matthew Laurich**, an active member who lives and practises in Calgary, Alberta, to be deserving of sanction on two citations.

The matters in which his conduct was found to be deserving of sanction included unwittingly engaging in conduct that enabled others to achieve an improper purpose and failing to serve his clients.

The Hearing Committee ordered, pursuant to Section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act* R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, that Mr. Laurich be suspended for five months, the suspension to begin on August 1, 2014. The Hearing Committee also ordered Mr. Laurich to pay costs of the investigation and hearing in the amount of \$46,851.58 within 6 months of his reinstatement.

A further Notice will be issued regarding arrangements for the management of Mr. Laurich's practice.

This Notice is issued pursuant to the requirements of Section 85 of the Legal Profession Act.
