Notice of Disbarment

On June 28th, 2006 a Hearing Committee disbarred **Mr. Martin John McDonald** who resides in Calgary, Alberta and practised in Calgary until August 27, 1996, when he was suspended by the Benchers pursuant to Section 60 of the *Legal Profession Act*.

The Hearing Committee found that Mr. McDonald's conduct was deserving of sanction on eight citations involving misappropriating funds from two clients, failing to serve two clients in a diligent, conscientious and efficient manner, deceiving a client, conducting himself in a manner which tends to bring the profession into disrepute, failing to properly respond in a timely manner to the Deputy Secretary and failing to be candid in responding to Law Society auditors.

The Hearing Committee ordered that Mr. McDonald be disbarred immediately, pay fines totaling \$1,100.00 and pay costs of the proceedings totaling \$104,267.96.

The Committee further directed, in accordance with section 78(6) of the *Legal Profession Act* that the Executive Director send a copy of the hearing record to the Minister of Justice and Attorney General.
