Suspension

On May 26, 2014, a Hearing Committee found the conduct of **Kristine Robidoux**, an active member who practices in Calgary, Alberta, to be deserving of sanction on two citations.

The matters in which her conduct was found to be deserving of sanction included disclosing confidential information and demonstrating a lack of candor in her dealings with others.

The Hearing Committee ordered, pursuant to Section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act* R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, that Ms. Robidoux be suspended for four months, the suspension to begin immediately. The Hearing Committee also ordered Ms. Robidoux to pay the actual costs of the investigation into her conduct and Hearing.

The partners at Ms. Robidoux's firm have assumed responsibility for her files.

This Notice is issued pursuant to the requirements of Section 85 of the Legal Profession Act.
