Section 61 Resignation – Deemed Disbarment

On October 11, 2017, a Resignation Committee of the Law Society of Alberta accepted an application by **James G. Burkinshaw** to resign pursuant to section 61 of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8. Mr. Burkinshaw is therefore disbarred, effective immediately.

Mr. Burkinshaw resides and practiced in Edmonton, Alberta, doing business as Burkinshaw Law Office. On April 12, 2017, the Law Society obtained a Custodianship Order for the property and business of Mr. Burkinshaw's law practice.

At the time of his resignation, Mr. Burkinshaw was facing four citations: failing to act with integrity when, without his client's knowledge or consent, he paid his legal fees with funds provided by his client for the sole purpose of satisfying a settlement; failing to follow his client's instructions to provide settlement funds to the opposing party; charging legal fees that were unfair and unreasonable; and breaching the accounting rules of the Law Society. Mr. Burkinshaw admitted facts in support of the outstanding citations and admitted further allegations, including: that he deliberately falsified a bank statement provided to the Law Society, breached trust conditions, took unfair advantage of opposing counsel, issued NSF cheques, failed to distribute an estate in a timely manner or as dictated by the Will, failed to properly account for a retainer received, failed to report a Writ of Execution to the Law Society and had a shortage in his trust account.

The Resignation Committee directed that Mr. Burkinshaw pay costs in the amount of \$9,259.04 and referred his conduct to the Minister of Justice and Attorney General pursuant to Section 78(6) of the *Act*.
