Disbarment

On November 14, 2017, a Hearing Committee of the Benchers of the Law Society of Alberta ordered **Terry Thomas** disbarred, effective immediately.

The Hearing Committee found that Mr. Thomas' conduct was deserving of sanction on 10 citations including failing to uphold the law, bringing the profession into disrepute, misappropriating trust funds, failing to follow trust accounting rules, exchanging legal services for the services of clients without providing the clients with statements of account and without recommending that the client receive independent legal advice, failing to properly serve his client, failing to cooperate with the Law Society, failing to follow the client's instructions and being ungovernable.

The Hearing Committee ordered that Mr. Thomas pay costs of the hearing in the amount \$150,000.00.

Mr. Thomas lives and practiced in Edmonton, Alberta. He had been suspended for non-payment of fees since July 15, 2009.
