## Disbarment

On December 12, 2017, a Meeting of the Benchers of the Law Society of Alberta took place to consider the making of an order against Justin Sidhu under section 83(4)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8.

Mr. Sidhu lives and practiced in Edmonton, Alberta. In 2013 he was charged with trafficking in a controlled substance, methamphetamine, and became an inactive member. In 2015 he was convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for four years. In 2016 the Court of Appeal dismissed his appeal of the conviction, and his status was suspended pursuant to section 83(7) of the *Act*. The matter was not appealed further.

In view of the conviction of Mr. Sidhu of the above referenced indictable offence, the Benchers ordered that he be disbarred, effective immediately. Accordingly, Mr. Sidhu is no longer a member of the Law Society of Alberta.

As Mr. Sidhu was not practicing before he was disbarred there is no custodian for his practice.
