On February 2, 2018, a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta found Clive O. Llewellyn, a member of the Law Society who lives and practices in Calgary, Alberta, to be guilty of misleading the lawyer for a mortgage lender as to the equity held by Mr. Llewellyn's client in a property.

On June 14, 2018, the Hearing Committee ordered that Mr. Llewellyn be suspended for 30 days commencing July 1, 2018 pursuant to section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act* R.S.A. 2000, c.L-8.
