Discharge of Custodianship

On February 5, 2019, the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta issued an Order under s.95 of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, C. L-8, discharging Brenda Edwards as custodian of the practice of Rakesh Kumar Dewett.
