## Suspension of Registration of Student-at-Law

On June 25, 2019, a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta found the conduct of Ivie Ihensekhien-Eraga, a student-at-law who lives and articled in Edmonton, Alberta from May 2017 until October 2018, to be deserving of sanction on one citation of failing to be candid with the Law Society. Pursuant to Section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act*, the Hearing Committee ordered a suspension of her registration for a period of 12 months and costs in the amount of \$17,000.00.
