## **Termination of Student-at-Law Registration**

On January 7, 2020, a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta terminated the registration of Sanjeev Sharma, a student-at-law who lives in Calgary and articled there until the termination of his registration. Pursuant to section 49(5)(b) of the Legal Profession Act termination of registration is equivalent to disbarment.

The Hearing Committee found Mr. Sharma's conduct to be deserving of sanction on two citations involving failing to be candid with his principal and the Law Society.

The Hearing Committee also ordered that Mr. Sharma pay the costs of the hearing in the amount of \$14,857.75.

As a student-at-law, Mr. Sharma did not have a practice and no custodian has been appointed.

The full written decision of the Hearing Committee will be posted to the Law Society of Alberta website when it is issued.
