## Suspension

On May 13, 2020, a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta (the "Law Society") found the conduct of Joseph Amantea, a member of the Law Society who lives and practices in Calgary, Alberta, to be deserving of sanction. Pursuant to Section 72(1)(b) of the Legal Profession Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, the Hearing Committee ordered that Mr. Amantea be suspended for one month, commencing May 16, 2020.

Mr. Amantea admitted guilt to two citations, which alleged that: (a) Mr. Amantea signed and swore affidavits of execution attesting that he had witnessed an individual sign documents when he had not witnessed the individual sign the documents; and (b) Mr. Amantea acted in a conflict of interest.

The Hearing Committee also awarded costs of \$10,132.50 payable within 60 days of the hearing.

The full written decision of the Hearing Committee will be posted to the Law Society website when it is issued.
