DISPOSITION SUMMARY – HE20180257

Brian P. Warrington applied to resign as a member of the Law Society of Alberta pursuant to section 32 of the *Legal Profession Act*. Mr. Warrington's Application was supported by an Undertaking to not apply for reinstatement, a Statutory Declaration, and a Statement of Admitted Facts.

Mr. Warrington faced seven formal citations, which consisted of allegations that he:

- failed to act in a courteous and civil manner towards another lawyer;
- sent repeated written communications to another lawyer that were offensive and inconsistent with the proper tone of communications;
- exhibited a lack of professionalism in correspondence to a self-represented litigant;
- failed to be courteous and civil to another lawyer;
- failed to provide competent, timely, conscientious, diligent and efficient service to his client;
- sent written communication to another lawyer that was inconsistent with the proper tone of communications; and
- failed to repay money owing to his client, as a result of a review or assessment of his account(s), until ordered to do so by the Court.

The Resignation Committee accepted the Application but reserved on the issues of publication (on the issue of full named basis or pseudonyms in the Resignation Committee Report) and costs (time to pay).
