DISPOSITION SUMMARY – HE20190195

Marcia Johnson, QC applied to resign as a member of the Law Society of Alberta pursuant to section 32 of the *Legal Profession Act*. Ms. Johnston's Application was supported by an Undertaking to not apply for reinstatement, a Statutory Declaration, and a Statement of Admitted Facts and Admissions of Guilt.

Ms. Johnston admitted guilt to nine formal citations, which consisted of allegations that she:

- 1. acted while in a conflict of interest;
- 2. failed to communicate relevant information to clients;
- 3. failed to act in a timely manner to register an interest in land;
- 4. failed to respond to clients in a timely manner;
- 5. inappropriately disclosed client information;
- 6. inappropriately disclosed details of a Law Society complaint against another lawyer;
- 7. failed to notify clients in a timely manner of a late payment of closing funds;
- 8. failed to disburse sale proceeds in a timely and accurate manner; and
- 9. failed to comply with Trust Safety requirements.

The Resignation Committee approved the Application and a Statement of Costs of \$15,315.86, to be paid before any application by Ms. Johnston to waive her undertaking not to apply for reinstatement.
