Suspension

On June 22, 2020, a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta, pursuant to Section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act* R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, ordered that **Mercy Amanoh**, a member of the Law Society who lives and practices in Calgary, Alberta be suspended for three months, commencing August 1, 2020.

The Hearing Committee found Ms. Amanoh guilty of four citations relating to real estate transactions: failing to conscientiously and diligently represent the best interests of her client, acting in a conflict of interest, failing to act in a thorough, conscientious and diligent manner in providing legal services to her clients, and unknowingly assisting others in carrying out fraudulent mortgage activities.

Ms. Amanoh was also permanently restricted from carrying on the practice of real estate and ordered to pay hearing costs in the amount of \$33,000.
