Section 84(3) - Direct Disbarment

On October 1, 2020, a Special Meeting of the Benchers of the Law Society of Alberta took place to consider an application to disbar Harjinder Singh Mann pursuant to section 84(3) of the Legal Profession Act. The Benchers ordered that Mr. Mann be disbarred, effective immediately.

On February 25, 2019, Mr. Mann was disbarred by the Law Society of Ontario ("LSO") for professional misconduct including misappropriation of trust funds, failing to follow his client's instructions for the distribution of trust funds, engaging in conduct unbecoming a lawyer by committing criminal offences, failing to report his criminal charges and convictions to the LSO, failing to follow the LSO's guidelines for suspended lawyers and failing to cooperate with LSO investigations.

Mr. Mann resides and practised in London, Ontario and extra-provincially in Alberta. At the time of his disbarment, Mr. Mann was a suspended member of the Law Society of Alberta.
