DISPOSITION SUMMARY – HE20200023

Jason McKen admitted guilt to one citation, namely that he failed to provide competent, conscientious and diligent service to his clients, and that such conduct is deserving of sanction.

The Statement of Admitted Facts, Exhibits, and Admissions of Guilt was accepted by the Conduct Committee pursuant to section 60(2) of the *Legal Profession Act*.

The Hearing Committee accepted the joint submission on sanction that Mr. McKen be suspended for two weeks, to start within 90 days of December 22, 2020, and pay costs of \$3,500.00. The Hearing Committee directed a referral to the Attorney General, and a Notice to the Profession will be sent pursuant to section 85 of the *Legal Profession Act* shortly before the start date of the suspension.
