Suspension

On January 25, 2021, a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta found **Kevan B. Peterson**, a member who lives and practiced in Edmonton, Alberta, to be guilty of twenty-one citations that may be summarized as follows:

- (1) Misconduct in relation to clients, including failing to keep clients informed, failing to respond, failing to follow instructions, failing to attend Court, failing to be honest, creating a false document, and failing to advance clients' legal matters;
- (2) Misconduct in relation to practicing law while suspended; and
- (3) Misconduct in failing to respond to the Law Society.

The Hearing Committee ordered that Mr. Peterson be suspended for thirteen months, starting immediately, and pay costs of \$12,547.50, pursuant to section 72 of the *Legal Profession Act*.

The Custodian appointed to Mr. Peterson's practice was discharged by Court Order on March 3, 2020. Any inquiries may be directed to the Custodianship Department of the Law Society of Alberta.
