DISPOSITION SUMMARY – HE20200080

Kevan Peterson was found guilty of conduct deserving of sanction on twenty-one citations, which generally fall into three categories:

1. Misconduct in relation to clients, including failing to keep clients informed, failing to respond, failing to follow instructions, failing to attend Court, failing to be honest, creating a fraudulent document, and failing to advance clients' legal matters;
2. Misconduct in relation to practicing law while suspended; and
3. Misconduct in failing to respond to the Law Society.

The Hearing Committee determined that the appropriate sanction was a thirteen-month suspension, effective immediately. Costs of \$12,547.50 are to be paid within one year of January 25, 2021.

The Hearing Committee directed that a referral to the Attorney General be made concerning the fraudulent document created by Mr. Peterson, and a Notice to the Profession will be published.
