Suspension

On June 17, 2021, a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta ordered that Austin Nguyen, a member of the Law Society who lives and practices in Calgary, Alberta, be suspended for five months commencing on June 21, 2021, pursuant to Section 72(1)(b) of the Legal Profession Act, RSA 2000, c. L-8. Mr. Nguyen was also ordered to pay costs of \$17,575.50.

Mr. Nguyen admitted guilt to six citations: breaching Rule 119.36 by failing to ensure that the records of his law firm recorded in a timely fashion the receipt of funds relating to the provision of legal services to a client; breaching the accounting rules of the Law Society by failing to deposit into trust funds received from or on behalf of a client and for which no accounts for services had been rendered; failing to issue accounts for services rendered in a timely fashion; failing to issue receipts for retainers; failing to be candid with the Law Society regarding accounting records and accounts; and assisting a client in an improper purpose in evading a Maintenance Enforcement Program garnishee.

Under the circumstances, the appointment of a custodian is unnecessary.
