## Suspension

On March 9, 2022, a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta ordered that Margaret Wheat be suspended for two months pursuant to Section 72(1)(b) of the Legal Profession Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8. Ms. Wheat previously practiced in Vermillion, Alberta, and lives in Marwayne, Alberta.

The Hearing Committee found Ms. Wheat guilty of one citation on September 16, 2021: acting without integrity by assisting her client in dishonest or fraudulent conduct.

The suspension will start on July 7, 2022 and conclude on September 7, 2022. Ms. Wheat was also ordered to pay costs of \$12,000.00, which have been paid.

Given that Ms. Wheat became a non-practicing member of the Law Society on June 30, 2022, the appointment of a custodian is unnecessary.
