Suspension

On January 31, 2023, a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta issued a decision finding the conduct of **Dana I. Carlson**, a suspended member of the Law Society who lives and practiced in Red Deer, Alberta, to be deserving of sanction on two citations. Mr. Carlson was found guilty of failing to serve his client and failing to reply to communications from the Law Society.

Pursuant to Section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, the Hearing Committee ordered that Mr. Carlson be suspended for six months commencing immediately. The Hearing Committee also ordered that Mr. Carlson pay costs of \$3,906.00 prior to reinstatement.

Mr. Carlson has not practiced law since he was administratively suspended on January 1, 2021. A custodian was appointed, wound up his practice and was discharged on January 6, 2023. Any questions regarding Mr. Carlson's former law practice may be directed to the Law Society.
