Section 32 Resignation in the Face of Discipline

A Resignation Committee of the Law Society of Alberta accepted an application by Greg John Lintz, a member of the Law Society who lives and practices in Edmonton, Alberta, to resign pursuant to section 32 of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8. Mr. Lintz's resignation is effective as March 12, 2024.

At the time of Mr. Lintz's resignation he was facing one citation alleging that he knowingly assisted a disbarred lawyer to practice law and that such conduct was deserving of sanction.

The Resignation Committee also ordered costs of \$22,472.24.
