Section 32 Resignation in the Face of Discipline

On August 28, 2024, a Resignation Committee of the Law Society of Alberta accepted an application by Christina Laughlin, a member of the Law Society who lives in Calgary, Alberta, to resign pursuant to section 32 of the Legal Profession Act, R.S.A. 2000 (Act), c. L-8. Christina Laughlin's resignation is effective immediately.

At the time of Christina Laughlin's resignation she was facing 20 citations alleging conduct deserving of sanction.
