Section 84(3) - Direct Disbarment

On September 18, 2024, a Special Meeting of the Benchers of the Law Society of Alberta was held to consider an application to disbar Lindsay Adam Christopher Ross pursuant to section 84(3) of the Legal Profession Act. The Benchers ordered that Mr. Ross be disbarred, effective immediately.

On March 19, 2024, Mr. Ross was disbarred from the Law Society of British Columbia. Mr. Ross was found to have to committed professional misconduct on the grounds that he had:

- Misappropriated trust funds from two separate clients;
- Misled clients, a lawyer, and the Law Society of British Columbia regarding trust funds received from a client:
- Acted in a conflict of interest:
- Facilitated a breach of a trust agreement; and
- Misled clients in relation to a purchase of real estate.

At the time of the disbarment, Mr. Ross was a suspended member of the Law Society of Alberta. Mr. Ross resides in British Columbia.
