Suspension

On December 2, 2024 a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta found the conduct of Ademola Emiloju, a member of the Law Society who lives and practices in Calgary, Alberta, to be deserving of sanction on three citations related to the following conduct: failing to treat the Court with candour, courtesy and respect; failing to correct a court order; and failing to provide required documentation and information to the Court, to an opposing party and to opposing counsel.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 72(1)(b) of the Legal Profession Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8 the Hearing Committee ordered that Mr. Emiloju be suspended for one month commencing December 3, 2024 and pay costs of \$2,000.
