Suspension

On April 1, 2025 a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta found the conduct of Manrai Singh Tiwana, a student-at-law who lives in Edmonton, Alberta, to be deserving of sanction on seven citations related to the following conduct:

- Being dishonest with clients and his Principal
- Wrongfully converting monies from his firm
- Engaging in Unauthorized Practice of Law
- Failing to comply with the requirements with the Trust Accounting and Client Identification and Verification Rules
- Being dishonest with the Law Society

Accordingly, pursuant to section 72(1)(b) of the Legal Profession Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, the Hearing Committee ordered that Mr. Tiwana be suspended for 20 months, commencing April 15, 2025, and pay costs of \$18,000.00.

The full written decision of the Hearing Committee will be posted to the Law Society of Alberta website when it is issued.
