Suspension

At the hearing on October 21, 2025, a Hearing Committee found **Erin Kuzyk**, a member of the Law Society of Alberta who lived and practiced in Calgary, Alberta, guilty of conduct deserving of sanction on 18 citations, which included the following misconduct:

- Failing to provide competent, conscientious, timely and diligent services to clients
- Failing to reply promptly and completely to communications from the Law Society
- Entering into a loan with a client who did not have independent legal representation
- Failing to immediately notify Trust Safety in writing of the issuance of writs of enforcement against her
- Failing to attend to finalization of a Court order in a timely manner
- Failing to be candid with the Court
- Failing to fulfil undertakings given to the Law Society
- Breaching Law Society Rules by practicing without approval of the Law Society
- Practicing law while administratively suspended
- Making misrepresentations to other persons regarding her legal practice
- Failing to be candid with her client
- Failing to comply with trust accounting rules, including by depositing a trust cheque into an authorized trust account
- Misappropriating trust funds from a client
- Failing to be candid with her lender regarding authorization to practice law

Accordingly, pursuant to Section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, on November 28, 2025, the Hearing Committee ordered that Ms. Kuzyk be suspended for 24 months, effective immediately, and pay costs of \$26,192.25.
