Suspension

On January 19, 2026 a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta found the conduct of **Nyall Bernard Carlyle DaBreo**, a suspended member of the Law Society who lives and practices in Calgary, Alberta, to be deserving of sanction on the following 3 citations:

- Bringing the legal profession into disrepute
- Breached Rule 105 of the Rules of the Law Society of Alberta by failing to report that he was charged with a criminal offence
- Practicing law while administratively suspended

Accordingly, pursuant to section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, the Hearing Committee ordered that Mr. DaBreo be suspended for 2 months, commencing immediately, and pay costs.

The written decision of the Hearing Committee will be posted to the Law Society of Alberta website when it is issued.
