Section 32 Resignation in the Face of Discipline

On February 5, 2026, a Resignation Committee of the Law Society of Alberta accepted an application by **Connor Barrett Dixon**, a member of the Law Society who lives and practiced in Foothills, Alberta, to resign pursuant to section 32 of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000 (*Act*), c. L-8. Mr. Dixon's resignation is effective immediately.

At the time of Mr. Dixon's resignation, he was facing two citations alleging conduct deserving of sanction.
