Suspension

On July 7, 2026, a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta found the conduct of Brady Gabert, a member of the Law Society who lives and practices in Rocky Mountain House, Alberta, to be deserving of sanction on the following three citations:

- Assisting his client in deceptive conduct;
- Lying to or misleading another lawyer; and
- Failing to act honourably and with integrity by giving false or misleading evidence under oath.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, the Hearing Committee ordered that Mr. Gabert be suspended for eight months, commencing September 1, 2026. Mr. Gabert was also ordered to pay a fine of \$12,500.00 and costs of the hearing.
