Suspension

On September 3, 2026, a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta found the conduct of **Anu Kumar**, a suspended member of the Law Society who lives and practices in Calgary, Alberta, to be deserving of sanction on 22 citations, including the following conduct:

- Failing to provide competent, timely, conscientious and diligent service to her clients in an immigration matter.
- Failing to respond promptly and completely to communication from the Law Society.
- Failing to act with candor, honesty and integrity in her dealings with her clients including by sending misleading documents to her clients.
- Using client funds for an unauthorized purpose.
- Improperly managing client funds, including by withdrawing funds from trust without delivering a Statement of Account contrary to the rules of the Law Society of Alberta.

Accordingly, pursuant to Section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, the Hearing Committee ordered that Ms. Kumar be suspended for 13 months and pay costs of \$45,608.18.

The written decision of the Hearing Committee will be posted to the Law Society of Alberta website when it is issued.
